



Publication of Public Reports – Internal Affairs

Per NJ Attorney General Guidelines regarding Internal Affairs Policy and Procedure,

Article 9.11 Public Records states:

“On a periodic basis, and at least once a year, every agency shall submit to the County Prosecutor and publish on the agency’s public website a brief synopsis of all complaints where a fine or suspension of ten days or more was assessed to an agency member. This synopsis shall not contain the identities of the officers or complainants, but should briefly outline the nature of the transgression and the fine or suspension imposed.”

As such, the NJIT Department of Public Safety is reporting the following public synopsis of disciplinary action for 2020:

- Police Officer was suspended for thirty (30) days for violating Departmental Code of Ethics, Core Values, Police Officer standards, Reporting, and failing to operate Body Worn Cameras / Mobile Video Recorder.
