

STUDENT HEALTH SERVICES AT SAINT MICHAEL'S PRIMARY AND SPECIALTY CARE CENTER

The Primary and Specialty Care Center at Saint Michael's Medical Center is providing NJIT students with student health services and medical care. The Center is conveniently located at 111 Central Avenue and students can access the Center from the Central Avenue or Martin Luther King (MLK) Boulevard entrance.

Here are some commonly asked questions:

Where is the NJIT Student Health Services at Saint Michael's Primary and Specialty Care Center located?

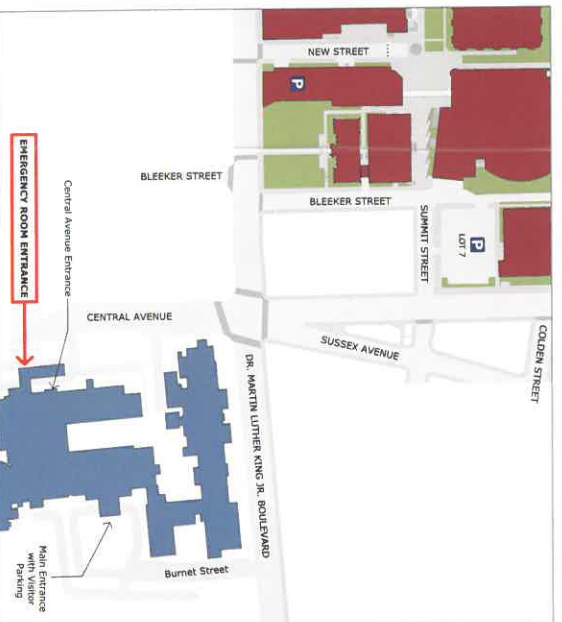
The primary entrance is located at 111 Central Avenue, Newark, N.J., or you can enter from the parking lot on MLK Boulevard at 268 Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd. Parking is available at both entrances.

Will there be a nurse on duty during the hours of operation?

There will always be a physician on duty when the Saint Michael's Primary and Specialty Care Center is open.

How far is NJIT Student Health Services at Saint Michael's located from the NJIT campus?

The Center is located directly across Martin Luther King Boulevard from the NJIT campus. See below.



When is the NJIT Student Health Center at Saint Michael's open?

The Saint Michael's Primary and Specialty Care Center is open the same hours as the former NJIT Office of Health Services. During the Fall and Spring semesters, hours of operation are Monday through Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Summer hours are Monday through Friday, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Does NJIT Student Health Services at Saint Michael's Primary and Specialty Care Center close for lunch?
No.

Do I need an appointment or can I walk into the Saint Michael's Primary and Specialty Care Center for services?

You should call the Saint Michael's Primary and Specialty Care Center at 973-596-3621 and press 5 to schedule an appointment. Although scheduling an appointment in advance is preferred, the clinical staff will see you on a walk-in basis.

Will I be charged a copay for services?

No, you will not be charged a copay.

How long do I have to wait to be seen?

There will be an NJIT Health Services Coordinator at the Saint Michael's Primary and Specialty Care Center to ensure that you receive priority registration to see a physician.

Is NJIT Student Health Services at the Saint Michael's Primary and Specialty Care Center open on holidays?

The Center is closed on the following holidays:

New Year's Day	Labor Day
Good Friday	Thanksgiving
Memorial Day	Friday after Thanksgiving
Independence Day	Christmas

How safe is it to walk from the NJIT campus to the Saint Michael's Primary and Specialty Care Center?

The NJIT Public Safety Department patrols the campus and contiguous community around campus. As such, NJIT community members may expect to receive the same level of service on their walk to Saint Michael's hospital. As always when walking on campus or in the surrounding area, please follow best practices for crime prevention. If needed, will transportation be available to Saint Michael's for students needing medical treatment?

NJIT Public Safety Department provides escort services on and around campus 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. The escort service, though designed for safety purposes, can assist you with getting to Saint Michael's Medical Center on a case-by-case basis. The Public Safety Officer assigned to the requested escort will assess each case and make a determination if he/she will assist or contact Emergency Medical Services for the transport. For non-emergency transports, please call 973-596-3111, for medical emergencies dial 9-1-1 from a campus phone, or dial 9-1-1 from your cell phone and tell the operator you are on the "NJIT Campus" followed by your exact location.

What should I do in case of a medical emergency?

Per normal procedure, you should either go to the emergency room or call 9-1-1 for assistance.

If I get sick on the weekend and the Saint Michael's Primary and Specialty Care Center is closed, where can I go for treatment?

Outside of normal business hours and per normal procedure, you should either go to the emergency room or call 9-1-1 for assistance.

If I do not have health insurance, will I receive services at Saint Michael's?

Yes, the only requirement to be seen is that you are an enrolled student at NJIT. You must bring your NJIT student identification card or proof of your current NJIT student status (i.e., copy of transcript).
