#### What is an absentee ballot?

 An absentee ballot is a ballot completed and typically mailed in advance of an election by a voter who is unable to be present at the polls.

#### Who can cast an absentee ballot?

 Any registered NJ voter may apply for an absentee ballot.

#### How to cast an absentee ballot?

Fill out an application by mail or in person


#### Deadline:
