Absentee Ballot

Have class on Election Day? Afraid you might not make it to your polling place?

You have the option to fill out an Absentee Ballot!

What is an absentee ballot?

- An absentee ballot is a ballot completed and typically mailed in advance of an election by a voter who is unable to be present at the polls.

Who can cast an absentee ballot?

- Any registered NJ voter may apply for an absentee ballot.

How to cast an absentee ballot?

- Fill out an application by mail or in person

Deadline:

- By mail: Received 7 days before election day
- In person: Received by 3pm on the day before election day
